Designed by esteemed yacht architect Marcelo Penna of Barcelon and constructed by Indonesia's traditional boat builders, Lamima seamlessly combines the authenticity of the two masted phinisi with the latest in yacht design and technology.

- At 65 metres long Lamima is one of the world's largest 5 star wooden sailing yachts offering a greater range and capacity than any other vessels in the region.

Raja Ampat

WEST PAPUA, INDONESIA

Remote and undisturbed, the breathtakingly beautiful islands of Raja Ampat are a nature lover's paradise.

Bursting with colour thanks to the incredibly healthy coral, the warm waters are home to reef sharks, manta rays and whale sharks and offer some of the best diving and snorkeliing opportunities in the world.

On land, many species of stunning birds of paradise inhabit the islands and can be seen on island treks or while paddle-boarding close to shore.

Locations such as Wayag are famous for their panoramic views and bays filled with small islands while local villages offer cultural excursions and some of the warments hospitality you will ever encounter.













Komodo & Flores

EAST NUSA TENGGARA, INDONESIA

Lying just to the west of Flores in Eastern Indonesia, the grassy sloped islands of Komodo National Park offer visitors gentle trekking trails and beautiful beaches to relax on.

Dolphins are a common sight and the area is also on a whale migration route. Teeming with sea life, the park's plentiful coral reefs are considered to be some of the best in all of Indonesia.

The National Park is also home to the famous Komodo dragons, the largest living lizards on Earth and found only on Komodo and Rinca Islands.

Heading eastwards, 17 islands National Park boasts huge colonies of flying foxes, colourful coral gardens and crystal clear water while Mt. Kelimutu's spectacular coloured volcanic lakes and Alor's tribal communities are real highlights.




