MOTOR PERFORMANCE

Built with an aluminium hull and powered by twin Caterpillar C32 ACERT engines (1,622 hp each), Katana X cruises comfortably at 12 knots and reaches a maximum speed of 17.5 knots.

She offers an impressive range of up to 3,500 nautical miles, making her particularly well suited to longer itineraries and extended cruising programmes.

Katana X features a beam of 8.50m, a draft of 2.00m, a half-load displacement of 235 tonnes, and an international gross tonnage of approximately 340 GT.

Built to RINA classification standards, she combines efficiency, reliability, and quiet onboard operation, delivering a smooth and refined experience underway.
