DECK

The expansive deck, crafted from thick teak planks, offers a bimini-covered area on the foredeck, perfect for open-air cocktails and dining. The entire deck forward of the bridge is dedicated to sunbathing, providing ample space to soak up the sun in style.

SALON

The salon features a formal dining room, a cosy lounge area, and a separate coffee and games corner. Interior spaces, adorned with beautifully inlaid teak and ash floors, are finished in rich mahogany and wild cherry. Watercolours and pastel furnishings add to the charm, creating an elegant 1930s-inspired atmosphere. A traditional companionway gracefully leads to the spacious staterooms, enhancing the seamless flow of the ship's timeless design.



CABINS



The 6 spacious cabins, crafted with traditional woodwork, are designed to create a serene and delightful atmosphere, even without the plush bed settings! The Master and VIP cabins each feature a luxurious Queen-size bed. Two standard Double cabins, each with a sofa (one of which can be connected to a bow Twin cabin), and two Twin cabins provide versatile accommodations. All cabins are fully air-conditioned, equipped with en-suite facilities and hi-fi audio, ensuring the utmost comfort and relaxation.

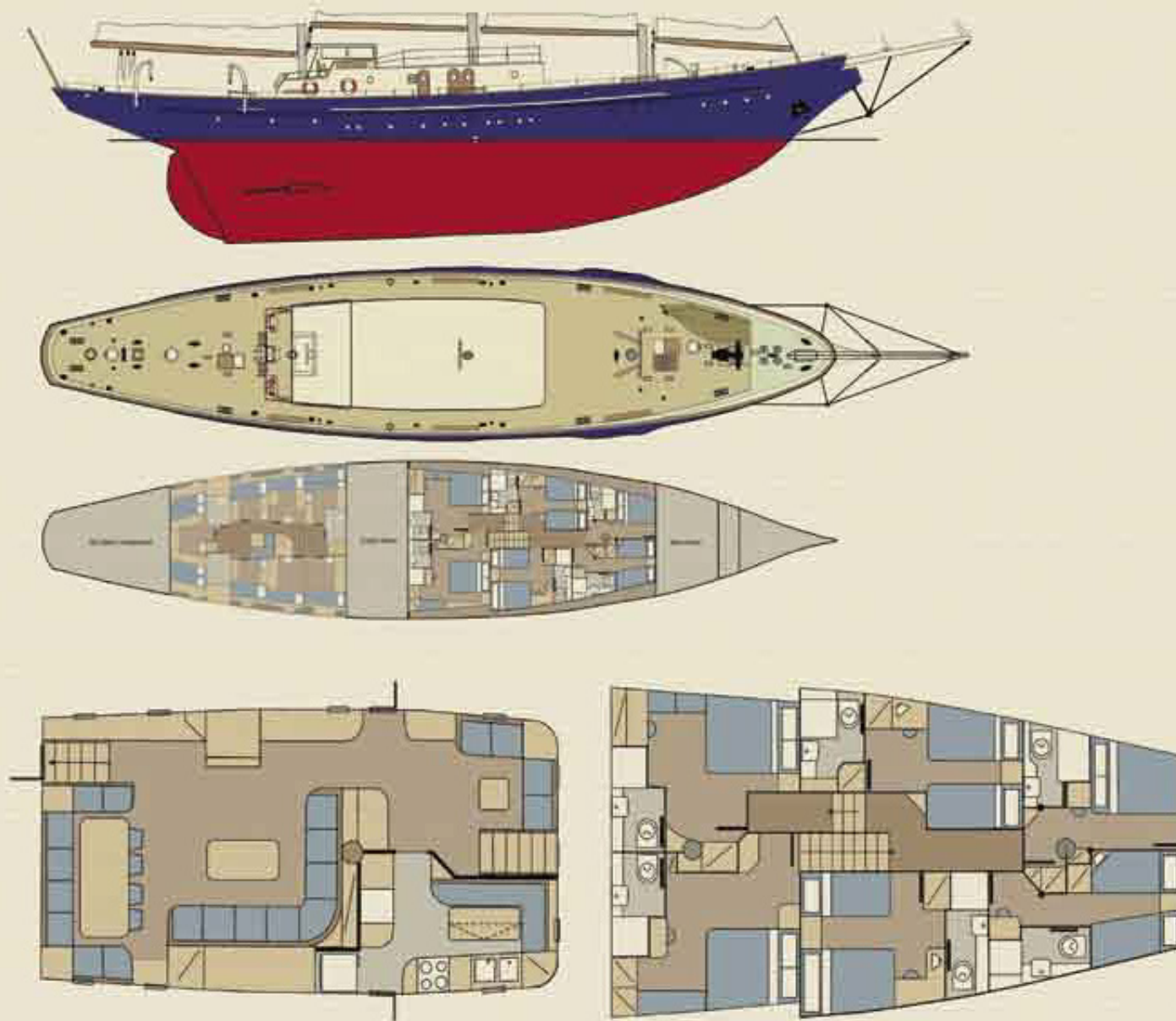
