ABOUT

Launched in 1954 and built by the renowned Danish shipbuilder Johannes Ring Andersen in Svendborg, MS Isbjørnen II was purposefully designed to navigate the demanding, ice-strewn waters of Greenland.

Today, this heritage of resilient exploration continues to shape the character of the vessel, combining authentic expedition pedigree with a more intimate and immersive way to experience remote Arctic landscapes.

Smaller and more agile than larger expedition ships, Isbjørnen II accesses isolated anchorages, sheltered coastlines and hard-to-reach wilderness beyond the reach of larger vessels, fostering a closer connection to the environment and a deeper sense of discovery among guests.

Accommodating up to 12 guests across six comfortable cabins, Isbjørnen II achieves an atmosphere that feels both relaxed and inherently social. Time seems to stand still – guests naturally engage with both crew and fellow travellers,

sharing experiences in an environment that feels informal and quietly welcoming against a backdrop of icy fjords.

Supported by dedicated crew members focused on both safety and the quality of the onboard experience, every journey is shaped by attentive expertise and a spirit of genuine hospitality.

After days filled with once-in-a-lifetime wildlife encounters and exploration, guests can return to hearty meals and comforting cuisine thoughtfully prepared by the onboard chef. Close interaction between crew and guests encourages a more personal style of exploration, prioritising authenticity over formality.

At the centre of life on board, the panoramic lounge becomes a focal point throughout the voyage, inviting guests to gather, reflect and fully absorb uninterrupted views of ever-changing scenery. Designed to immerse passengers in their surroundings, it offers a comfortable setting for

quiet observation, shared conversation over a drink or a boardgame, and moments of awe between excursions.

Active exploration remains central to the experience, with frequent Zodiac landings providing access to isolated shorelines, remote wilderness and otherwise inaccessible corners of the landscape.

Less curated and more genuinely exploratory in spirit, Isbjørnen II is designed for travellers who seek not simply to witness extraordinary places, but to experience them more deeply – forging lasting connections, shared discovery and moments that endure long after the journey ends.

GREENLAND

Disko Bay is one of Greenland's premier exploration destinations, boasting an exceptional density of icebergs and active glaciers. Sailing routes alternate between isolated villages, deep fjords, and vast expanses of ice. A spectacular and still relatively undiscovered destination, ideal for exclusive itineraries.

SVALBARD & SPITSBERGEN

Spitsbergen in summer offers a unique immersion in the heart of the Arctic, with continuous sunshine and ideal conditions for exploration. Sailing allows you to get close to glaciers, drifting ice floes, and Arctic wildlife (bears, walruses, whales). An iconic destination with a very high perceived value, perfectly suited to adventure travelers.

NORWAY

In summer, Norway reveals the full splendour of its fjords, with long days, soft sunlight, and spectacular sailing. The itineraries allow you to explore wild areas, accessible only by sea, with great flexibility. An ideal destination for adventure cruises combining scenery, hiking and sailing.

No fixed itinerary. The journey adapts in real time to weather, wildlife and guest preference.



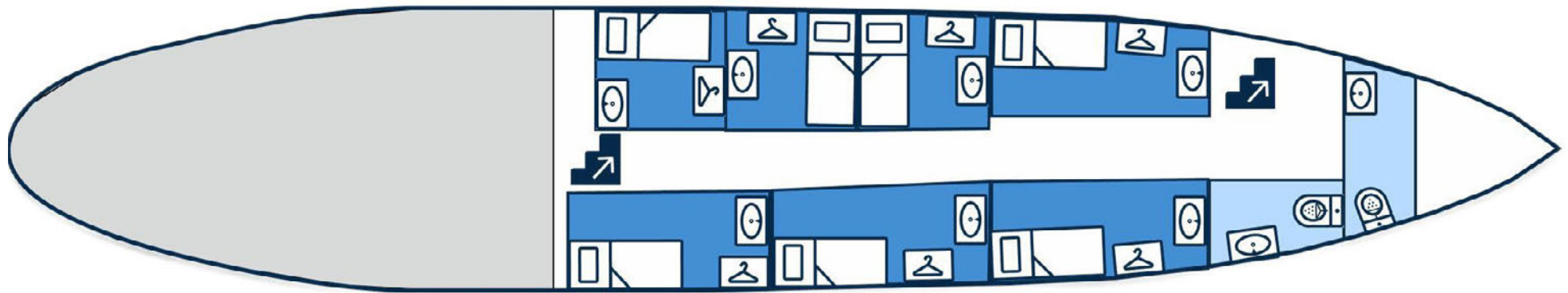
