

















CREW PROFILE

Since they were very young, they have chosen to dedicate themselves to life at sea and to the world of sailing charters, offering guests their natural, in-depth knowledge of the sea, their professionalism and their overwhelming joie de vivre.

In fact, this is the great pride of this boat, a professional crew, capable of making both experts and first-time sailors feel at ease, who love to share the experience of sailing and encourage sports activities, shore excursions. They are always on the lookout for wonderful anchorages, able to take advantage of the weather conditions and the light of the sunsets and to create dreamlike atmospheres.

His several charter experiences guarantee a high professionalism.

Captain Francesco at the age of 20 started his own Windsurfing and Sailing School in Stromboli, Aeolian Islands; at 23, he bought his first catamaran Manutara, which was one of the first catamaran in the charter business around Sicily. In 1986, he crossed Manutara to the Caribbean, the first of 13 Atlantic crosses, and 13 winter charter seasons in the West Indies.

In the 2003 began the precious partnership with the current ship owner of the Kaskazi, the Pahi 63' catamaran located in Kenya. They sailed a chartered Kaskazi during the winter season in the Indian Ocean on the East Coast of Africa up to now.

Over the years, Francesco never missed a summer sailing season in the Aeolian Islands that he loves and knows as few other people and where he has his home and heart. Volcanology, Geology, Archeology, Speleology Biology, Diving, snorkeling, Water sky, Kayak Windsurf, good restaurants and happy nightlife: with Francesco, you will never get bored!

Some of his clients call Francesco "the poet of the sea" for his natural attitude or talent to enjoy and let enjoy the life on the water and the art to be at the right moment at the right place with his boat and guests. He loves fresh, healthy Mediterranean food and wines, and is also a popular cook. Very friendly and patient, Francesco loves children and sharing with them his knowledge of sailing, the sea and maritime life and, of course, the use of all water sports equipment.


Now is seven years that sail together with Francesco, they are running Kaskazi Four alternating in command and sharing the love for the sea and navigation.
