Quattroelle – Italian for Four ‘L’s: Love, Life, Liberty, Luxury. She’s a masterful expression of Italian style and the owner’s unique personality. But a closer look at the Quattroelle’s state-of-the-art engineering and excellent craftsmanship reveals another L: Lürssen.

In the words of naval architect Dan Lenard of the yacht design firm Nuvolari Lenard: “We wanted to create a true piece of Italian design – bold, streamlined, elegant. And we wanted her built with uncompromising dedication to excellence. That’s why we didn’t settle for anything less than the yachtbuilding heritage and unsurpassed German engineering of Lürssen.”





**F**rom bow to stern, the Quattroelle reflects the values behind her name. At 86.11 meters, she's a family yacht built for pure pleasure and love of life as well as the freedom of self-sufficiency during extended voyages on the high seas, regardless of the weather and climate. For sunny days, the outside aft bridge deck features a large infinity swimming pool with jet flow surrounded by luxurious sun beds.







The aft decks are equipped with ample seating for relaxation. Triangular awnings, fixed on carbon-fiber poles, provide optimum sun protection.

















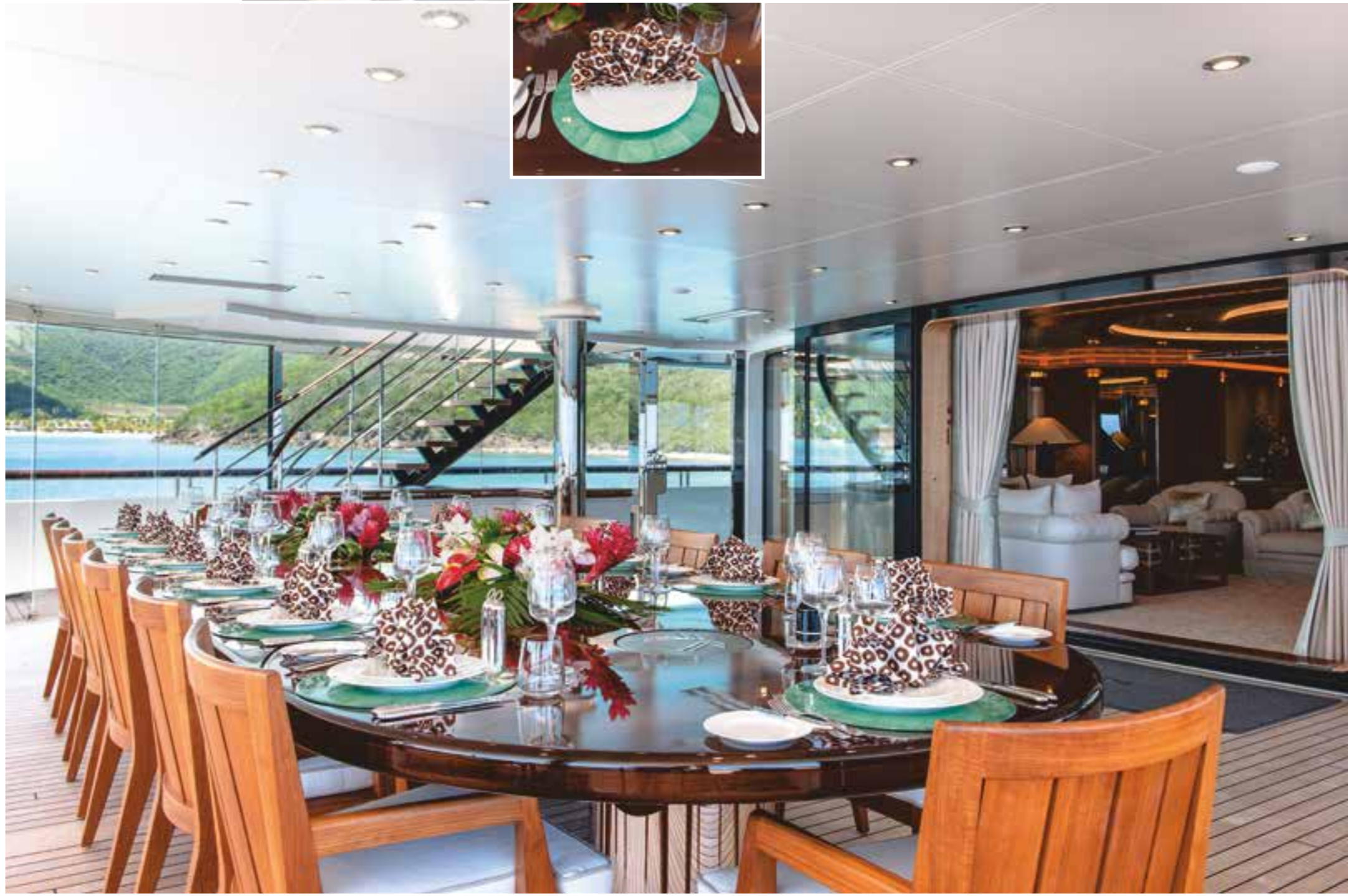




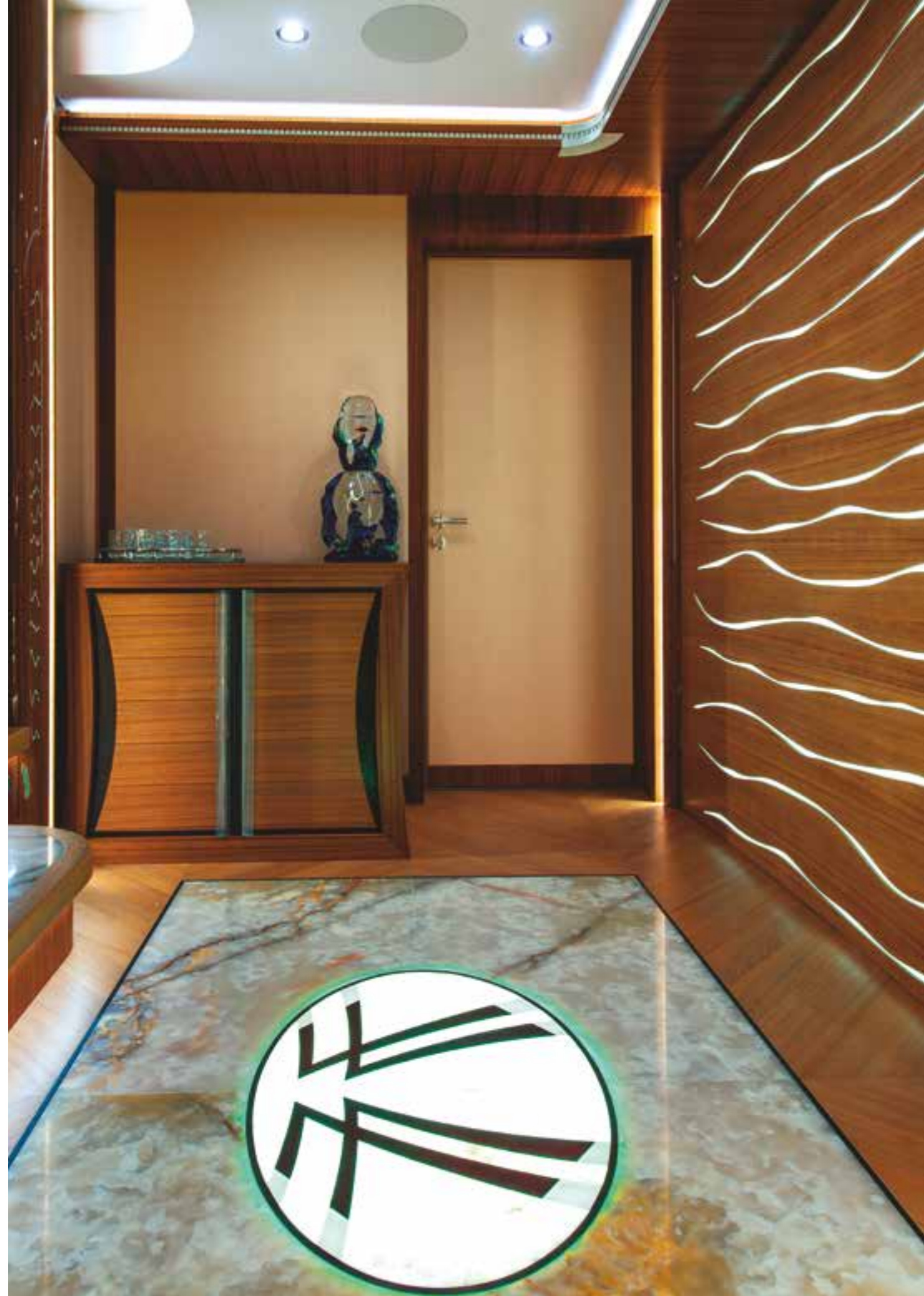


The spacious outside upper aft deck is designed for various activities. The exterior dining area can be adapted for up to 18 guests and the aft deck

can be almost entirely enclosed by sliding glass panels, turning it into a conservatory at sea. Additional overhead heaters ensure comfort in colder climates or chilly weather conditions.







*E*xtraordinary sophistication and refinement are unmistakable on entering the Quattroelle's wood- and marble-floored foyer through the main entrance. It features an elevator that connects all decks as well as a staircase fitted with a unique hand-wrought bronze balustrade – a dynamic and fluid element that sets the tone for the interior design throughout the vessel.







Vast space with comfortable couch areas are the main features of the library and formal main salon. The colors vary from a warm brown to beige and blue. Each piece of furniture has been specially designed and crafted with a sharp eye to detail. Highlights include decorative elements in exquisite blue glass and boldly curved joinery components.











The elegant formal dining salon seats up to 20 guests and, if desired, can be completely separated from the main salon and library by means of beautifully inlaid sliding doors. The Murano glass chandelier and the dining table are both true works of art. The forward wall is covered with leather, hand-stitched and richly tooled with a floral pattern.











With ample seating, a large TV screen as well as a bar and a self-playing Steinway piano, the VIP salon offers luxurious relaxation and entertainment options. The large windows let in plenty of light, which brings the earthy colors of the interior materials to life and creates a special atmosphere of peace and comfort.









The owner's suite provides sweeping, forward-facing panoramic views. An external private seating area, accessible through side doors, adds to the cabin's versatility. The suite has a warm décor in keeping with the interior's overall contemporary look.







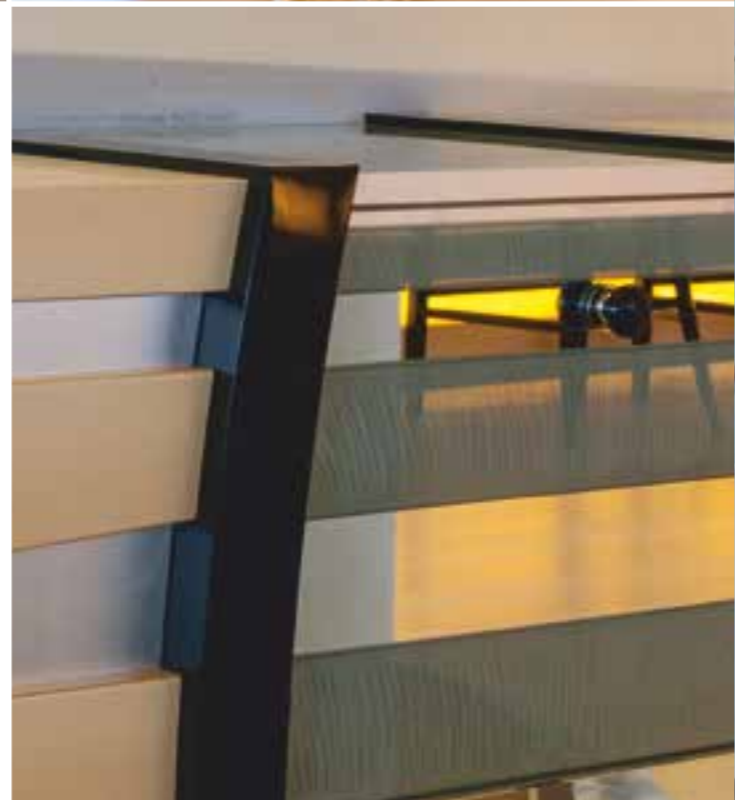
Spacious and luxurious his and hers bathrooms offer a Jacuzzi in addition to a large shower. A walk-in wardrobe the size of an extra cabin provides plenty of space for clothing. Two children's cabins are adjacent to the owner's suite.







With furniture in subtle shades that glow in delicate turquoise and bright yellow tones in the sunlight, the owner's salon aft is a quiet and intimate space. It features fascinating glass artwork.











The main deck is home to five guest suites, each with its own unique décor. They all share a warm brown, beige and blue color scheme.









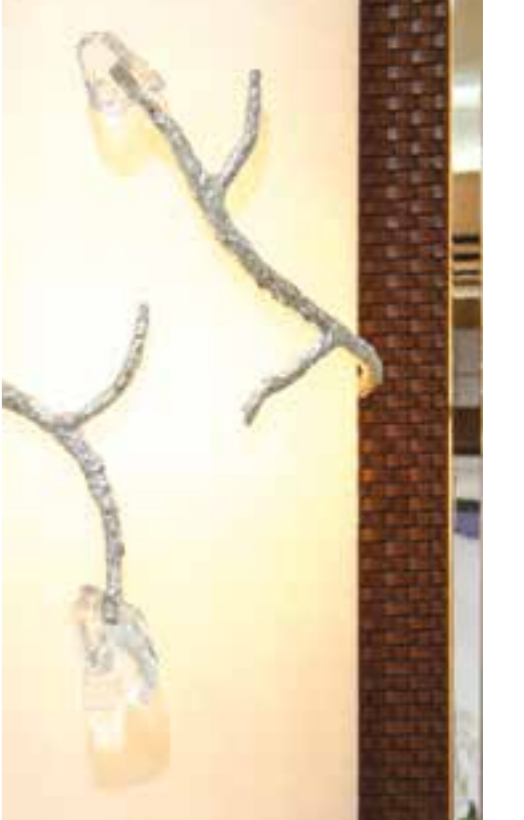


With the guest suites on the main deck, passengers and crew are clearly separated. The generous accommodations feature very large windows that allow ample natural light to enter.





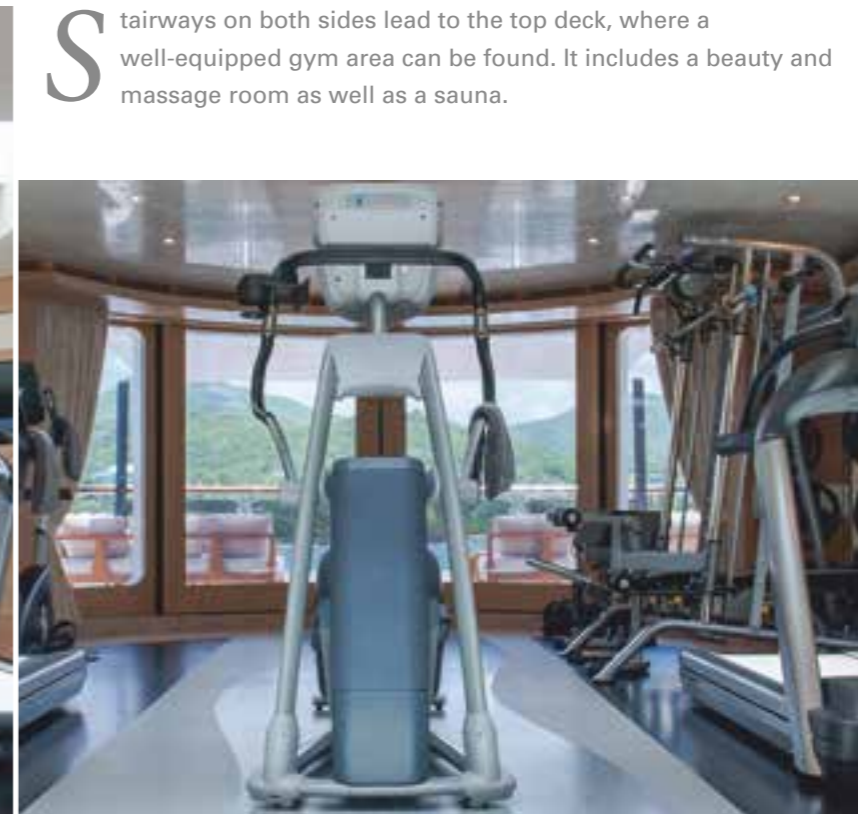
The VIP suite has its own dressing room. Its delicate colors are set off by the natural light.







The modern galley with its large work surfaces is constructed entirely of stainless steel. Its professional equipment is every chef's dream come true.



Stairways on both sides lead to the top deck, where a well-equipped gym area can be found. It includes a beauty and massage room as well as a sauna.







One of the ideal places for relaxing and recharging on the yacht is the cinema. The room is large enough to accommodate all guests on board.





The large tender garage is located on the lower deck and holds two 9.78 m Colombo/LT tenders, one limo tender and one open tender, designed by Nuvolari - Lenard. The tenders can be launched sideways through the hull doors. In addition to the tenders and the dedicated diving equipment room, there is plenty of space for any other kind of water-sport equipment.



A fold-out swim stair makes ocean swimming easy and convenient.







*I*n addition to the state-of-the-art wheelhouse, the bridge deck houses a radio room and the ship's office.



Quattroelle is powered by two Caterpillar engines of 2,000 KW each, reaches a top speed of 17 knots and has a range of 6,000 nm. Advanced sound and vibration-reduction features guarantee extremely quiet running. She is of course fitted with zero speed stabilizers and lies very comfortably on the water.
