THE SUITES

MY The Wellesley sleeps 12 guests in six cabins, all en suite. Featuring bespoke furniture, black and white portraits and bevelled mirrors, the1920s styling and crisp linen ensure that the suites are a seamless extension of the hotel.

Suites consist of The Owner's Suite - with panoramic sea views; The Master Suite; The VIP Suite; One Double and Two Twins (both convert to doubles for maximum flexibility).



MASTER SUITE

The full beam Master Suite on the lower deck has been completely refurbished with leather panelling, rich mahogany and bronze detailing, as well as a sumptuous en suite. The bathroom has a bath and a shower, as well as a walk-in wardrobe.







BATHROOMS

Each of the expansive bathrooms has been designed individually, using hand-selected Arabescato Corchia marble from the Cararra region in Italy.

Everything – from the bath towels and robes to the Hermès amenities – is consistent with the hotel.







MAIN SALOON

With panoramic sea views, the main saloon comfortably seats 12 and is an ideal gathering point for afternoon tea, or casual meetings before jumping in the tenders to go ashore.



CLUB LOUNGE

A collection of the world's finest cigars are showcased in the impressive, bespoke humidor onboard, in synergy with the hotel's renowned Cigar Lounge.

Featuring a connoisseur's selection, guests can enjoy a Montecristo, Cohiba, or limited edition Bolivar paired with Cognac, in the Club Lounge or on the connecting outdoor smoking deck.





DINING

Should you choose to host a dinner in complete privacy, the dining room on MY The Wellesley rivals the best onshore restaurants for fine-dining and service.

The Wellesley custom made dinner service is designed for afternoon tea, corporate lunches and celebrating family events.

Alternatively, choose the silver service lay for formal dinners, where Baccarat crystal, Christofle silverware and Wedgewood crockery set the tone.

Two vast outdoor dining areas mean you can ensure variety over the course of your charter.

OUTDOOR DINING

MY The Wellesley offers two vast outdoor dining spaces on both the main deck and sun deck. Both dining tables seat up to 12 guests comfortably on 4.5m long tables and can be laid for both casual and formal events.







SPILLPOOL & CRASH PAD

With more than 40 square metres of outdoor deck space on three levels, MY The Wellesley offers the definitive entertaining space.

On the sundeck, the spillpool seats 8, while the surrounding crashpad is the social epicentre of the yacht. Across the main and lower decks, sunpads, Dedon sofas and Indian Ocean loungers offer plenty of further relaxation space.





BBQ GRILL & BAR

Watch the sunset from the bar with 360 degree views, before enjoying a casual seafood barbeque, or stone baked pizza on the BBQ grill.

After supper, watch a movie at the outdoor cinema with its state of the art AV system.





BEACH CLUB

For guests who like to be close to the water, the Beach Club offers every conceivable entertainment.

Two tenders: a 10m chase boat and 4.5m sea tender, are on hand to transport guests to and from the shore, to explore the coastline or attend dinners and events.

The inflatable jetski dock makes it easy for guests to hop on and off without the need for a crew chaperone. There are two jetskis and one waverunner at your disposal, and MY The Wellesley is accredited to offer PWC licensing.

Besides the inflatable kayaks, tow-rings, and stand-up paddleboards, a sundeck-to-waterline freestyle slide and two underwater F5 Seabobs will delight adventurous spirits. A netted saltwater pool offers safe swimming for families.

Huge sliding doors, a side platform and a rise-and-fall rear transom mean that the Beach Club offers sea breezes and panoramic views. At nearly 8m wide it's an ideal spot for afternoon drinks parties.

Alternatively, guests can book a massage with the onboard masseuse while listening to the water lapping the hull.
